

UNIFORM POLICY

Uniforms reflect the importance and seriousness of learning as well as foster pride in being a member of this school community, self-respect, and self-discipline. Students begin wearing uniforms in Kindergarten. **Uniforms are expected to be clean, in good condition, and each item labeled with the student's name.** The St. Clare uniform consists of the following:

Boys Uniform

- K-5th grades: Navy blue pants or shorts
- K-5th grades: White collared shirt
- 6th-8th grades: Khaki pants or shorts
- 6th-8th grades: White collared or green collared shirt (green colored shirts must be ordered from Dennis Uniform)
- K-8th grades: White, gray, black or navy socks
- K-8th grades: Green Dennis Uniform school sweater
- K-8th grades: St. Clare Sweatshirt/Hoodie

Girls Uniforms

- K-5th grades: Navy blue pants or shorts
- K-5th grades: White collared shirt
- K-8th grades: Dennis Uniform plaid jumper, skirt or skort
- 6th-8th grades: Khaki pants
- 6th-8th grades: White collared or green collared shirt (green colored shirts must be ordered from Dennis Uniform)
- K-8th grades: White, gray, black or navy socks
- K-8th grades: Green Dennis Uniform school sweater
- K-8th grades: St. Clare Sweatshirt/Hoodie

Green sweaters are worn for Mass on Wednesday and on field trips. P.E. shirts may not be worn on field trips unless stated on the field trip permission slip. Polo shirts, turtlenecks, and undershirts should be tucked in at all times.

P.E. Clothing

The P.E. uniform consists of a pair of gym shorts (not more than 4 inches above the knee) and a St. Clare P.E. t-shirt. These must be work for all P.E. classes. K-5 wear their purple P.E. shirts to school on gym days. Grades 6-8 leave P.E. clothing at school and change into their P.E. shirts before class. P.E. clothing must be taken home once a week for washing. Shoes must not leave black marks on the gym surface. A pair of gym shoes, labeled with the student's name, should be left in school during the year.

Ordering Uniform Clothing

Green Uniform sweaters/vests, girls jumpers/skirts/skorts, and middle school green collared shirts must be ordered from Dennis Uniform, located in Gesco Place, 8600 Park Meadows Drive, Lone Tree, CO 80124 (near the Park Meadows Mall in Denver). You can also order online at http://www.dennisuniform.com or over the phone at 303.738.2255. Use St. Clare School Code CA7 when ordering from Dennis Uniform. We are currently in the process of contracting with Dennis Uniform for PE Shirts and Hooded Sweatshirts; this should be complete by Summer 2019 and these items can be ordered from Dennis Uniforms.

The navy pants/slacks and white collared shirts may be purchased through the uniform company or at a store of your choosing (e.g., GAP, French Toast, Target, Costco, Walmart). If they are purchased elsewhere the color/style must match the pants/slacks from the uniform company and follow the additional details outlined in the uniform policy chart.

Out-of-Uniform Days

Out-of-uniform days will be held on the First Friday of every month. The following guidelines should be followed on out-of-uniform days:

Clothes must be modest in all circumstances (no low cut or sleeveless tops) and may include jeans (no holes, patches or rips), casual shirts, T-shirts, sweatshirts (no improper words or pictures), shorts (knee length), skirts for girls (knee length or longer), or sports related clothing. Both boys and girls should wear shoes and socks or sandals. No flip-flops are allowed. Leggings cannot be worn as pants, no pajamas, no spaghetti strap tees/shirts, no exposed shoulders or midriffs, no hats. Determination of whether a clothing item is acceptable is at the discretion of the principal.

Failure to follow Uniform Policy

Students wearing clothes that do not meet the uniform policy chart expectations will be given a uniform violation card. After three violations, the consequence outlined in the Family Handbook for a student in that grade level will be enacted.
